<b><i>Application</i></b>	<b>Expert Spot Cleaning for Carpets and Fabric</b>
<b><i>Features &amp; Benefits</i></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Works on 90% of stain types with an 80% success rate.</li> <li>• Easy to use two-pack system</li> <li>• Safe on the majority of fabrics</li> <li>• Great for tea, coffee, red wine etc.</li> </ul>
<b><i>Dilution</i></b>	<p><b>1. StainTech Universal (Activator) 1 x 500ml Bottle</b> <b>2. StainTech Universal (Anti-stain Agent) 30 sachets</b></p> <p>Activator Pre-Spray Solution is ready to use.</p> <p>Active Solution to be made up just prior to use as outlined below:</p> <p>Fill the bottle with tepid (Not hot) water to the top of the label.</p> <p>Using the funnel empty 1 sachet only into the bottle and mix with the stirrer bar then attach trigger. Do not apply before the Activator.</p> <p><i>Take care not to spill any granules or solution. In case of spillage ensure all the granules are removed and use our acidic Rinse to remove the solution and balance the pH in the fabric.</i></p> <p><b><u>StainTech Universal (Anti-stain Agent) 30 sachets</u></b></p> <p>Avoid using this product on natural fibre such as wool, nylon, viscose and silk.</p> <p>Always test on an inconspicuous area before doing large surface. Note: These instructions are intended to be general not exhaustive. The technician should determine which preparation and techniques are best suited to the specific surface.</p>
<b><i>Equipment Required</i></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Extractor machine charges with Fibre and Fabric Rinse</li> <li>• Tamping brush</li> </ul>
<b><i>Use Instructions</i></b>	<p><b>IMPORTANT:</b> Before starting ensure that your extractor machine is charged with a solution of Rozone acidic rinse. This is especially important with wool, wool blend and cotton carpets</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Vacuum the area to be treated to remove particulate dirt.</li> <li>2. Spray the stained area with the Activator Solution taking care not to saturate carpet.</li> <li>3. Gently massage the solution into the stain with a gloved hand or a tamping brush.</li> </ol>

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>4. Spray the stained area with Anti-stain Agent Active Solution ensuring complete coverage of the stain but do not saturate.</li><li>5. Leave to work for a few minutes. You will see stains fading.</li><li>6. Rinse and extract the solution.</li><li>7. If stain is still visible repeat the treatment until stain is no longer visible.</li></ol>
<b><i>Hints &amp; Tips</i></b>	<i>Activator Pre-Spray Solution provides pre-treatment for fibres and activator for the Anti-stain Agent.</i>
<b><i>Precautions</i></b>	<p>Ensure lid of air tight container is re-sealed after use.</p> <p><i>Do not over use the product...if after two or three attempts the item has not responded then stop the process.</i></p> <p><i>Always apply the Activator first.</i></p> <p>Discard any remaining Anti-Stain solution after use. Do not carry made up solution in the back of the vehicle as the bottle has pressure release and <b>will</b> leak.</p>
