Features & Benefits	<ul> <li>Lower chemical consumption when used correctly</li> </ul>
	Powerful pre-cleaning
	Safe on delicate paint work
	Safe for food vehicles
	Suitable for use with oil separators
Dilution	Light Soiling: 1% (1:100)
	Medium Soiling: 2% (1:50)
	Heavy Soiling: 3% (1:30)
Equipment Required	Fixed gantry/low pressure spray arch
	<ul> <li>Rozone low-pressure pre-spray equipment</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Alternatively low pressure chemical spray canister</li> </ul>
	Source of high pressure fresh water for rinsing
Use Instructions	Fleet Clean Pre-Spray can be used hot or cold. For best results use hot.
	<ol><li>If using a hand held low pressure sprayer dilute to desired concentration in the spray canister.</li></ol>
	<ol><li>If using the Rozone Low Pressure Pre-spray Equipment set the chemical feed to the desired concentration.</li></ol>
	<ol> <li>Apply detergent to the vehicle starting at the bottom and working upwards.</li> </ol>
	<ol><li>In hot weather pre-cool paintwork with cold water and do not allow detergent to dry onto the surface.</li></ol>
	6. Rinse off with high pressure cold water.
Hints & Tips	For areas of heavy soiling higher concentrations can be used with longer dwell times.
Precautions	Always observe precautions in material safety data sheet.
	Do not allow chemical to dry onto paint work.
