# Pressure Washing Cleaner Economy

<b><i>Application</i></b>	<b>Pressure Washing Cleaner Economy</b>
<b><i>Features &amp; Benefits</i></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• NTA-Free – safer to use</li> <li>• Optimised performance at minimised cost</li> <li>• Biodegradable formulation</li> <li>• Versatile – manual or pressure washer use</li> </ul>
<b><i>Dilution</i></b>	<p>Light Soiling: 2% (50:1)</p> <p>Medium Soiling 3% (30:1)</p> <p>Heavy Soiling 5% (20:1)</p>
<b><i>Equipment Required</i></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pressure washer</li> <li>• Suitable dilution vessel</li> <li>• Bucket/Mop</li> <li>• Water supply</li> </ul>
<b><i>Use Instructions</i></b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Pressure washing cleaner economy may be used hot or cold via a pressure washer. For best results use hot.</li> <li>2. Suitable dilutions are normally established by experience. See guidance above.</li> <li>3. Apply product at low or high pressure working from the bottom upwards. This avoids streaking on cleaned vehicle.</li> <li>4. In hot weather cool paintwork with water before applying chemical. Do not allow the chemical to dry on the surface.</li> <li>5. Rinse with a bucket, hose or pressure washer from the top of the vehicle, rinsing downwards evenly and methodically.</li> </ol>
<b><i>Hints &amp; Tips</i></b>	<p><i>For the very best results, use warm water (&lt;60°C at machine)</i></p> <p><i>To avoid cleaning-streaks, always work from bottom to top of vehicle.</i></p>
<b><i>Precautions</i></b>	<p>Always observe precautions in material safety data sheet,</p> <p>For fresh or damaged paint/livery always check compatibility on an inconspicuous area first.</p>
